



**GUIDELINE FOR TEAM MANAGEMENT NUMBERS**

As at 13 July 2007

Universities participating at AUS events will be subject to this Guideline which outlines the maximum number of non-playing officials that should be registered for any AUS event.

**Application**

- All AUS events – national, regional and other endorsed events.

**Purpose**

- To limit the unnecessary team management personnel registering for free at AUS events.
- AUS supports the attendance of spectators and university supporters but they should not be registered unnecessarily. If they do not form part of the team they should not be registered as an event participant.

Under special circumstances AUS will grant permission to enter additional personnel. Requests should be made in writing to the Project Manager of the Event.

Additional officials nominated (over and above the stated maximum) may incur an administration fee to be determined by AUS.
